

# **BLACK SOAP** (paste)

#### **FEATURES**

Authentic BLACK SOAP from Marrakech in 100% natural paste made according to ancient Moroccan traditions from olive paste, water and sodium hydroxide. BLACK SOAP owes its natural coloring to olive paste, it contains no coloring, no preservatives, no solvents, it is a completely ecological and biodegradable product.

It can be used in a variety of ways, and can replace ten cans of conventional cleaners:

- For household cleaning (dishes, laundry, floors, windows, etc.), to degrease, remove stains and nourish materials (tiles, terracotta, parquet floors, marble, ceramics, porcelain, etc.).
- For the treatment of insects (mites, aphids, scale insects, etc.).
- For the hygiene of domestic animals, natural shampoo, washing of cow and goat udders.
- To protect limewash, plaster and stucco, to finish Tadelakt and to clean brushes.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

### Housekeeping

For small surfaces, a dab of BLACK SOAP on a damp sponge is more than enough.

For larger surfaces, dilute two to three tablespoons of BLACK SOAP in five liters of water.

For a stain on clothing, apply a small amount of **SAVON NOIR** directly to the dry garment, rub lightly then put in the washing machine.

#### Insect treatment

Dilute a little BLACK SOAP in hot water and spray the mixture directly onto the affected areas.

# Pet hygiene

Dilute two to three tablespoons of BLACK SOAP in five liters of water.

#### Decoration

Dilute two to three tablespoons of BLACK SOAP in five liters of water.

To finish and protect lime stucco, apply the solution with a brush to the still-fresh smooth plaster, then finish with a roller or trowel.

To protect limewash and plaster, apply the solution with a brush to the dry surface, adding a little water if necessary to avoid brush marks.

However, be aware that applying the BLACK SOAP solution will slightly darken the initial shade and give a slightly satiny appearance.



To clean brushes, soak them in the BLACK SOAP solution.

#### **CONSERVATION**

**BLACK SOAP** can be stored for 1 year in its original, tightly closed packaging, away from frost and extreme heat.

## **PACKAGING**

BLACK SOAP is sold in 1 kg and 10 kg plastic jars.
